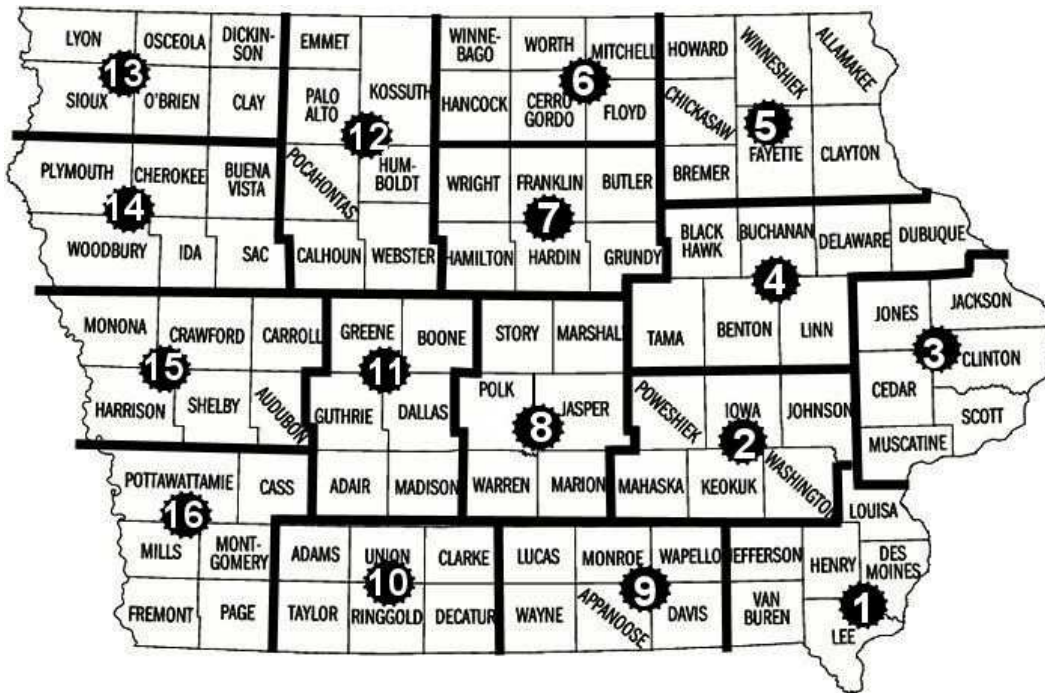

Notes on Iowa Civil War Soldiers Who Were Members of the Colorado & Wyoming Grand Army of the Republic

The Grand Army of the Republic, often referred to as the GAR, was founded in Decatur, IL on 6 Apr 1866 under the leadership of Dr. **Benjamin Franklin Stephenson** who had served as Surgeon of the 14th IL Infantry during the Civil War. Dr. Stephenson created the organization in response to the desire of many veterans to re-experience the friendships and camaraderie they developed and shared with their comrades during the war. To become a member of the GAR, a man must have served in the United States Army, Navy, Marine Corps, or Revenue Cutter Service (today's United States Coast Guard) between 9 Apr 1861 and 12 Apr 1865. He must have been honorably discharged from the service and have never taken up arms against the United States of America. Local organizations were called Posts, and it was to a Post that a man applied for membership in the GAR. Posts from a state or region joined together to form Departments and the Departments formed the National Organization.^{20,21}

During its active years, the GAR had a significant influence on politics, law, and social programs in the United States. Memorial Day was established as a national holiday, five GAR members were elected Presidents of the United States, many of the Governors in the northern states were members, soldiers' homes were founded, veterans' relief programs were established and ever more valuable pensions were given to the Union veterans. In many cases it was impossible to be elected to public office if you were not a veteran of the Civil War and did not have the support of the GAR. National Encampments were yearly meetings that attracted over 25,000 veterans in the 1890's. By 1890 when the GAR was reaching its peak, membership reached almost 500,000. The final Encampment of the Grand Army of the Republic was held in Indianapolis, IN in 1949.^{20,21}

The GAR in Colorado and Wyoming was originally organized as the Department of the Mountains on 11 Dec 1879, and later re-designated as the Department of Colorado and Wyoming on 31 Jul 1882.⁴ At one time or another there were 109 individual Posts within the Department, the great majority in Colorado.²⁻⁴ Virtually any town of appreciable size had a functioning Post. Larger cities, such as Denver (with at least eight), had multiple Posts.²⁻⁴

This article is based on a Roster of the Department of Colorado and Wyoming published in 1910 which provides then current rosters for most of the active Posts in the Department.¹ In building the list provided here, the service of identified Iowa veterans was verified against the rosters published by the Iowa Adjutant General.⁵ This source also provided information on the location to which the soldier was credited and where he was born. Pension information was used to identify instances when these veterans served in more than one unit, including those of other states, during the conflict.^{6,7} These citations were in turn verified against the Adjutant General's records from those states. Rank at the veteran's severance from the service is indicated. (Note:

This means that if a soldier enlisted as a Sergeant and was promoted to Captain, only the latter rank is given. Conversely, if a soldier enlisted as a Corporal, but was later reduced to the ranks, his rank is shown as “Private Pension”. Sources also often provide other information useful to genealogists in tracing the movements of these veterans, such as dates and locations where pension applications were made, dates and locations of the veterans’ death and the name of surviving spouses. Taken together, this information provides a thorough overview of each soldier’s military history. (A key to abbreviations used is provided at the end of the article.)

It is also important to note what this list is not. It is not a complete list of Iowa Civil War veterans who resided at one time or another in Colorado and Wyoming. While the GAR was the largest Civil War veterans’ organization, not all veterans belonged to it. Whether due to political reasons, absence of a conveniently local Post or other reasons, some veterans chose to eschew membership. This is also not a complete list of Iowa veterans who were members of the GAR in Colorado and Wyoming over the entire period of the organization’s existence. The published roster is a snapshot of the membership in 1910. Other veterans may have been members, but died or relocated prior to 1910. Others may have migrated to these two states and joined the local GAR after 1910.

David Hockett along with his wife Mary Jane Hanks and their children: James, Nancy, and Stephen David, came to Earlham, Madison County, Iowa in 1865. They had been living near Salem, Henry County, Iowa with extended family. They left the Salem area by ox team and wagon. Upon arriving, David bought land from Seth Wilson. Subsequently David owned land that would later be part of the town of Earlham. David sold part of his land for town development and to the C.R.I. & R. railroad.

The Hockett House is an example of a small settler's home of the 1860's. Originally it was a one- room house which over time has acquired a dining room, kitchen, two bedrooms and a parlor. This house was also involved in the Underground Railroad. A door is marked for museum viewers to see.

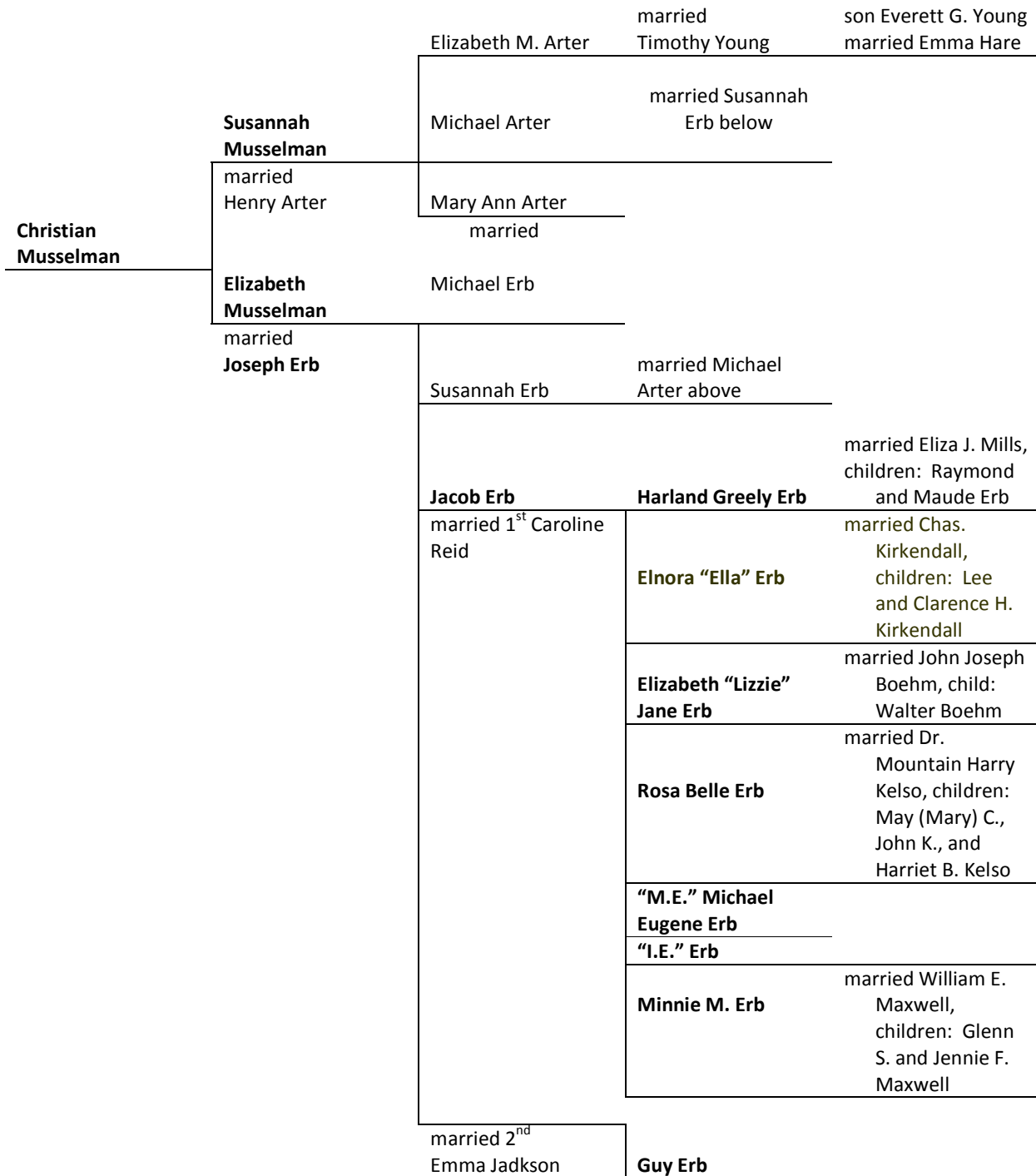
The Hocket House Museum is open to the Public from Memorial Day weekend to September 30th on Sundays from 2 to 5PM. Admission is free.

United Spanish War Veterans

By Susan Claman

The Spanish-American War lasted less than a year from 21 April 1898 to 11 April 1899 although actual hostilities ceased on 13 August 1898. Fifty-seven thousand three hundred twenty nine (57,329) regular troops participated, 223,235 militia and volunteer troops and 31,959 Navy personnel (this number includes officers in the US Marine Corps but not officers in the US Navy proper) for a total of 312,523. Soon after the men returned home they began to form veterans' organizations. Originally there were several organizations. In 1904 three of the most prominent merged into a single organization known as the United Spanish War Veterans (USWV).

The TAPS (Tragedy Assistance Program for survivors) form included the name of camp, camp number, department of (state), file date, name and highest rank in USWV, US Service (highest rank), Co, ship/regt, married or single, number and age of children, place of birth, place of death, date of death, buried in <blank> cemetery at <blank> with military honors, grave in charge of and camp number.

The following is a partial index of the death records we have at the IGS library. All information is transcribed as written on the form. To obtain a copy of the one record (1 sheet, two sides) send a request to IGS. The cost is \$5.00 for members or \$7.50 for non-members plus \$1.00 for postage and handling.

One of the most frequent requests to the Iowa Genealogical Society is asking help to find a cemetery. To see an alphabetical list of Marion County cemeteries go online to <http://www.co.marion.ia.us/cemeteries.htm> and a four page list can be viewed and printed. By clicking on any name you can view a map to find the general location. To see a better map go to www.iowaassessors.com and click on the county, Marion County in this case, and after entering the site you can type in the name of the cemetery. Putting in "Asbury," for example, gives you a picture of the front gate. "Little Flock" gives you an aerial view. Even a defunct site such as Timber Ridge will give you a page with location. In all cases you can click on the map icon in upper left corner to get an aerial view which can be zoomed in or out & moved around with your mouse. The outline of the cemetery will be highlighted to show you where it is. To overlay section lines try <http://ortho.gis.iastate.edu> and open the Iowa Geographic Map Server Viewer. Pioneer cemeteries are those which have had less than 12 burials in the last 50 years, and they are marked here (P).

“No access to public” means the cemeteries have no immediate access from a road. They must be walked to across private land, or driven to across field roads, often with a high clearance vehicle, and in some cases are not visible from a road & hard to find.

Three **townships were abolished** due to the damming of Des Moines River to create Lake Red Rock.

Perry Township, in the northwest corner, and the smallest, went to Red Rock Township to the east. Swan Township went to Pleasant Grove Township on the south. Polk Township north of the river went to Summit & that part south of the river went to Knoxville Township.

These **cemeteries were moved** because Lake Red Rock covered the sites:

East Burch, 30-76-19 & Eagle Rock, 18-76-19, both in Knoxville (North),
Phillips-Fink, 18-76-18, Lake Prairie (South),
Donahoo, 16-77-21 & Groom, 22-77-21, both in Pleasant Grove (formerly Swan Twp),
Vanden Berg/Van Hemert, 11-76-19, in Summit (formerly Polk Twp).

These **cemeteries have been destroyed** which means there is no physical evidence that they ever existed:

Nepas, Franklin Twp., 35-75-21
County Poor Farm, Knoxville Twp., 14-75-20 - a building on the site.
Bethel Church, Lake Prairie (North) Twp., 20-77-18 - both church & cemetery destroyed.
Wagner, Red Rock(former Perry)Twp., 2-77-21 - both farm & gravestones gone.
These have not been found & probably have been destroyed:
Burkhalter, 29-77-19, Fisher, 22-77-19, Jelsma, 36-77-19, Honndel, 13-77-19, Hornwald, 25-77-19,
Pendroy, 16-77-19, West, 34-77-19, all 7 in Summit Twp.
Timber Ridge, aka Van der Linden cemetery, Lake Prairie (South) Twp., east of Hwy T 15 just north of Red Rock Dam, 17-76-18, has no gravestones. Two burials were moved to Oakwood & unmarked graves were probably left. A 3-page article with color photo & genealogy on this Leendert Van der Linden family is in April 2002 MCGS newsletter.
Loynachan, Clay Twp., 19-76-18, two stones not on site & moved to this farmstead.

Marion County Resources for the Family Historian

Marion County Genealogical Society is at Knoxville Public Library, P.O.Box 385, Knoxville IA 50138. The society has a separate room on the second floor and has the same hours as the library. Look at the website <http://iagenweb.org/marion/> for many interesting topics. But as genealogical societies say, the internet is just the tip of the iceberg. Many more records are found in libraries. For example, the Society has microfilmed probate records different from that in the State Historical Library. The most complete collection of local history for Marion County can be found here.

The Society offers a Newsletter, use of a copy machine, and meets three times a year on Saturday. The society has published census indexes for all years, 1850-1930, a 600-page hardbound book on the county's cemeteries with an every name index, a death index for 1976-1990, and two books on marriages, 1845-1944.

The Library address is: Knoxville Public Library at 213 E. Montgomery, Knoxville IA 50138, and the phone number is 641-828-0585.

Marion County Historical Society at POBox 21 Knoxville IA 50138, has a museum in its eight-building historical village located in Marion County Park on Willetts Drive, west Knoxville and just south of Highway 92. This museum has many local history books and scrapbooks on many topics, especially clippings from 19th century Knoxville newspapers. Vertical files on many topics are kept in several file cabinets. The museum is open weekends during the summer and has a copy machine. The Society has monthly meetings, except winter, on the third Monday of the month.

Marion County Courthouse is on the town square in Knoxville, IA. Auditor and Recorder are available for original land records, and Clerk of Court has divorce & court records.

Pella Public Library at 603 Main St Pella, IA 50219, has a Heritage Room that is set aside for family history books, school yearbooks, local history, and microfilmed newspapers.

Central College Geisler Library, Archives Room, at 812 University, Pella IA 50219 and Pella Public & Central College library holdings are online at <http://www.pella.lib.ia.us>. To access the Archives at Central College contact the Library Director, Nancy Hutchinson, 641-628-5220 for an appointment. The archives here are not limited to Central College but also on early Pella history.

Pella Historical Society Archives at 507 Franklin St Pella, IA 50219, is accessible only to members and by appointment only. The archives room in the historical village contains an extensive country school collection from the Marion and Mahaska Counties. There are photographs and original records located in this collection.

Webb-Shadle Memorial Library at 301 W. Dallas St. Pleasantville, IA 50225, is a public library just east of the high school and has some local history. The phone number is 515-848-5617.

The mission of the newly formed Marion County Pioneer Cemetery Commission is looking after some of the 50 pioneer cemeteries.

Monroe Public Library at 416 S. Buchanan St. Monroe, IA 50170, is in southern Jasper County. There is an obituary collection including many people in northern Marion County in the Monroe school and the postal area. The phone number of the Monroe Library is 641-259-3065.

Iowa State Historical Society Library is located at 600 E Grand Ave Des Moines IA 50309. The library is located on the second floor of the Historical Building and is best accessed from Grand avenue directly across from the Iowa Genealogical Society headquarters and library.

Iowa Genealogical Society (IGS is at 628 E Grand Ave Des Moines, IA 50309. The IGS has information about Marion County and just about all Iowa counties are represented by two shelves of county history material. There are census records for all years.

Each source above has something no other place has. For example, baptisms for the Second Reformed Church in Pella are in a book at IGS. Burial records in chronological order for Oakwood Cemetery in Pella are in the Marion County Genealogical Society in Knoxville.

Iowa Pioneer, Century & Statehood Certificates

The **IOWA CERTIFICATE** project is available for anyone whose ancestor was in Iowa during specific time periods. Sources of proof can be census, county history, Bible record, land record, etc. The completed application and copies of proof are filed at the library for the patrons' use.

Application for Certificates

The Iowa Genealogical Society issues certificates to persons who are directly descended from Iowa Pioneers. Applications must prove direct descent and prove that the ancestor settled in Iowa

- By 1846, to receive a **Statehood Certificate**;
- By 1856, to receive a **Pioneer Certificate**;
- More than 100 years prior to the date of application, for a **Century Certificate**.

Applicants may apply for certificates to be issued to themselves or to other persons. The person to whom the certificate is issued need not currently live in Iowa.

The purpose of the Certificate Program is to recognize families with Iowa roots, encourage people to undertake genealogical research, and to provide genealogical resources for researchers in our library.

My Wild Cracked Brains: A Story of Personal and Historical Discovery

“You can tell Mrs. Graham that we heard from the boys about three weeks ago.” They was all well at that time but they are suffering for clothing and something to eat.

Pvt. William Love of Company B, 7th Illinois Volunteer Infantry, included these few words of encouragement for a family friend in a letter to his wife, dated Sept. 13, 1864, during the bloodiest war on American soil — the Civil War.

“Mrs. Graham” was Lurana Graham. She was the mother of “the boys” — William and James, fellow members of Company B. And, as I was to discover, she also was my greatgreat-great-great grandmother.

At the time of the letter, William and James were “suffering” in the stockade of Andersonville Prison. For 10 months, they lived in two of the most reviled Confederate prisons, Andersonville and Florence Stockade. This was a story lost to history and the Grahams’ descendents, until I unearthed their wartime correspondence.

Growing up, it was my grandfather, Thomas W. Tye Sr., who shared a short — but intriguing — bit of familial lore. According to my grandfather, two obscure uncles from his mother’s side — the Grahams — fought in the

Civil War and spent time in the notorious Andersonville Prison. Both men, names unknown but understood to be brothers, survived prison, but one died on his way home to Iowa. Letters the men wrote home supported the story. But the cache sat undisturbed and bound with string in the vault of our family law firm for more than a half century. Forgotten by our family and ignored by history.

Three years ago, my mother found copies of the letters during a move. With the copies in hand, I began sleuthing. What began as a simple inquiry into my genealogy soon shifted into a multi-year research project during which I traveled across the country searching for the tiniest of clues.

Under the guidance of my advisers, Tracy Leavelle, Ph.D., and Heather Fryer, Ph.D., both of the Creighton history department, I began exploring the Grahams' story, their lives, motivations and relationships during the war. A grant from the College of Arts and Sciences supported my research this past summer. Research at the National Archives in Washington, D.C.; the Abraham Lincoln Presidential Library in Springfield, Ill.; the New York Historical Society; and the Cass County History Museum in Griswold, Iowa, helped me fill in the holes in the brothers' story.

I quickly discovered that the men, William and James, were not obscure uncles. In reality, James is my great grandfather and William was his eldest brother. Both grew up in a family of 12 on a farm just outside Mattoon, Ill.

As the nation descended into war, both men answered President Abraham Lincoln's call for troops to suppress the rebellion. In the fall of 1861, William enlisted in Company B of the 7th Illinois Volunteer Infantry for three years service. James, just 19 at the time, followed his brother a month later. Members of their family were not happy with the brothers' decision. Jonathan and Lurana Graham, their parents, were both Southerners by birth. William described the sentiments at home, noting that, "Some says it is a silly notion that has got into my wild cracked brains whilst others say it is for some scandalous action why I wander so far from home."

In spite of their family's concern, William and James remained in the 7th Illinois and re-enlisted in 1864. Under the leadership of Ulysses S. Grant, the 7th Illinois fought across the western theater of the war, from early victories at Fort Belmont, the famed Battle of Shiloh and eventually marching to the sea under Gen. William Tecumseh Sherman.

The Civil War claimed the lives of some 620,000 Americans. (Based on current U.S. population figures, that would be the equivalent of 6 million war dead today.)

While the number of troops killed in action reached upwards of 200,000, more than double that figure died from sickness and disease. Constant drilling during the early weeks of their enlistment took its toll on the brothers. William writes, "we would travel till we was ringing wet with sweat ... and then lay down on the ground and sleep with our wet clothes on. That is what made so many sick."

Early in the war, the brothers didn't see any direct combat. James was home resting after a serious illness contracted in camp and William found himself on the sidelines. At the Battle of Belmont, Gen. Grant's first foray into combat during the war, William was in reserve, but he visited the battlefield afterward and observed an "awful scene, the dead lay four deep." James returned to the 7th Illinois by the end of 1861. And on Feb. 11, 1862, the brothers directly fought in their first battle at Fort Donelson in Stewart County, Tenn. They were the second unit over the fort's walls and played a crucial role in the course of the five-day battle.

After the victory at Fort Donelson, the 7th Illinois traveled down the Tennessee River, aboard the steamboat Fairchild, to Pittsburg Landing, Tenn. On April 6 and 7, 1862, the brothers took part in the Battle of Pittsburg Landing, commonly remembered as the Battle of Shiloh.

William wrote, "Our men attacked them and such volleys of musketry and canon never was heard in the United States."

At that time, Shiloh was the bloodiest battle in U.S. history, with some 19,900 troops either killed or wounded in two days. The brothers survived, and, at the end of April, joined the 7th Illinois as it laid siege to the city of Corinth, Miss.

In October, the Confederates attempted to retake the city and during the course of the battle, William was shot through the shoulder. Writing from his hospital bed he told his parents, "I thought it would kill me, I thought my head would burst" from the pain. Once healed, he made his way back to the 7th Illinois, after which both he and James re-enlisted for another three years of service as veteran members of the unit.

On May 7, 1864, while out on mounted patrol along the Tennessee River, the Grahams and 28 other members of their unit were captured by Confederate forces. For the rest of the war, the brothers remained in Confederate captivity, first in Andersonville Prison in Georgia and eventually Florence Stockade in South Carolina. They joined approximately 25,000 prisoners in Andersonville, known to be one of the worst prisons during the war. An estimated 13,000 died while in captivity. The brothers survived on cups of corn meal and polluted water for more than six months.

As the Union forces under Gen. Sherman's command, including the rest of the 7th Illinois, marched toward the sea, the prisoners at Andersonville were shipped to other prisons still under Confederate control. William and James were sent to Florence Stockade, which rivaled Andersonville in the suffering it caused. Prisoners were known to slice off diseased fingers and toes in order to survive. The only food was rotten corn meal. Yet again, both brothers survived.

Once it appeared the war was over, the prisoners in Florence Stockade were shipped to Wilmington, N.C., and marched to within three miles of the Union lines. At the end of his life, James reflected on the last days of captivity in a 1922 interview, "When (I) came out, (I) could not walk. (I) was Helped by (my) brother to our line. There (we) became separated. I never saw him again alive."

After separating from James, William was admitted to the General Hospital in Grafton, W.Va., on March 8, 1865, with typhoid fever. A little over two weeks later, on March 24, he died. He was 34 years old. William was laid to rest in what became the Grafton National Cemetery. James returned to the family farm in Mattoon, Ill. Making a similar trip across the country were William's personal belongings. All William had to his name at death was the clothing off his back and a hefty \$73 dollars in back pay.

Their mother signed the receipt for the goods, now in the National Archives, with a simple X. Lurana was illiterate. Following her husband's death in 1863, other members of the family had to read William and James' letters aloud. She would hold onto them until her death in 1905.

In 1875, James and his young wife, Melvina, moved to Iowa where they started a family, first with Marcella and then Nathan, my namesake. James established a farm just west of Griswold, Iowa, that remained in our family until the late 1990s. James and Melvina are buried in Whipple Cemetery just outside Griswold — only a short drive from the Creighton campus. It's interesting to note that every Memorial Day our family visited the grave of James' son, Nathan, to lay flowers, but we never noticed the grave just beside it. No one ever read the inscription or saw the bronze Civil War veteran star sticking out of the ground. For years we strolled right by James' grave and never made the connection.

William and James survived the entire war, relying on one another to endure the stress of combat, the boredom of camp life and the horrors of Confederate captivity. They were brothers bonded by more than blood. Having marched across the country to quell the rebellion, they witnessed some of the greatest and darkest moments in our history. James lived to tell his story, sharing it with other veterans and ensuring that his and William's letters, preserved by their mother, remained in the family. It was from these letters that I rediscovered their story.

The exploits of William and James are no longer obscured by the fog of time and human memory. As the nation marks the 150th anniversary of the Civil War through 2015, it is important to remember the men and

women of “remarkable or unremarkableness,” as historian Reid Mitchell describes it, who fought and died on either side of that bloody conflict”.

A Little Bit of History on the Effects of the Civil War in Iowa

There were no significant battles in Iowa, but the state sent large supplies of food to the armies and the eastern cities. 76,242 Iowa men (out of a total population of 674,913 in 1860) served in the military, many in combat units attached to the western armies. 13,001 died of wounds or disease (two-thirds of the total). 8,500 Iowa men were wounded. Cemeteries throughout the South contain the remains of Iowa soldiers that fell during the war, with the largest concentration at Vicksburg National Cemetery. A number also died in Confederate prison camps, including Andersonville prison.

Iowa contributed 48 regiments of state infantry, 1 regiment of black infantry (the 1st Iowa Volunteer Infantry Regiment (African Descent)), 9 regiments of cavalry, and 4 artillery batteries. In addition to these federally mustered troops, the state also raised a number of home guard or militia units, including the Northern Border Brigade and Southern Border Brigade, primarily for defense of the borders. Other local units included the Sioux City Cavalry.

Naturalizations - First Papers

The Iowa Genealogical Society received a number of naturalization documents from the district court files in Polk Co. Volunteer members scanned the documents and, when the ink was faded, transcribed the information. Great care was taken to assure each name was correct with the coordinating scan. The documents were then indexed for easy use.

The images on this page are available to IGS members for \$5.00 or to non-members for \$7.50 per sheet plus \$2.50 postage and handling by writing to IGS (see page 1 for the address) with the requested names. The front side, back side and transcription for an individual all are included in the mailing.

The indexing of the naturalization images used the following guidelines.

- If there was more than one date on a document, the earliest date was used in the name. The dating system of "year-month-day" was used.
- If the immigrant's signature was legible, his spelling was used for the name.
- If the name was difficult to decipher, other volunteers were consulted. Census indexes, city directories and Ancestry.com were also used to determine the name.
- In the rare instance of not being able to decipher a given name, the symbol ^^ is used with the first initial of the name.

- There are a few documents in which the immigrant wrote his first name and the clerk wrote a different or similar name; i.e. Johannes vs. Jonathan or Charles vs. Carl. In these cases, the immigrant's signature was used as the name with the clerk's interpretation in parentheses.
- If the document originated in another County, the document was filed in Polk County, Iowa.
- Even though the document was larger than 8x11 inches, the information on the back side may not have been that large. So the backside was usually scanned at the 8x11 size. No information was omitted to do this.
- Depending on the original paper size, the document was bi-folded or tri-folded to about 3x8 inch size. The name was written by the court clerk across one end for filing. This resulted in the "back side" of the document.
- There were some documents where the name on the backside did not agree with the name on the actual document. (Sometimes this is the name of the court clerk, which is the first name appearing on the document).

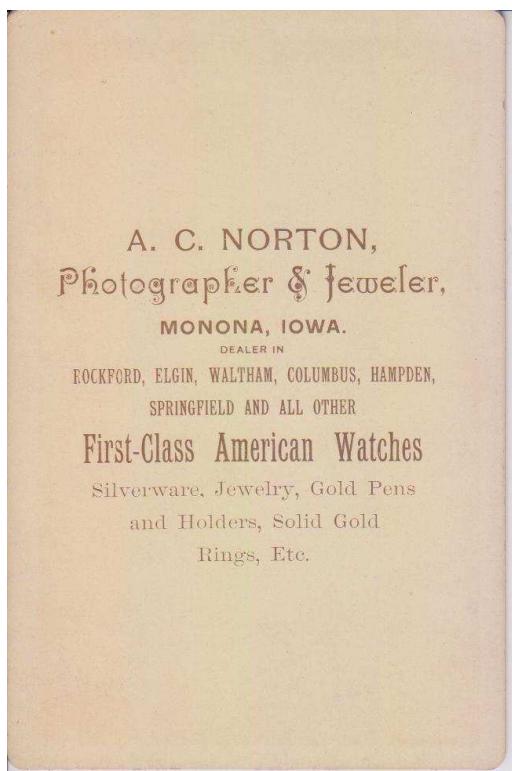
